ABSTRACT

The purposes of this creation is: I want to give everyone the message of happiness with the image is funny, happy, friendly of dogs through language created Figure and another purposes is the dogs in my paintings will be the messengers bring joy, my happiness to share with you.

The data were collected and divided into four groups in this study which were: primary inspiration, documentary data, and influence creative work presses by some typical Pop art artists are: Andy Warhol, Roy Lichtenstein, Robert Rauschenberg, David Hockney, Jasper Johns, Tom Wesselmann, Alex Katz. And some typical Graffiti artists are: Taki 183, Joe 136, Barbara 62, Eel 159, Yank 135, Eva 62 and data of the creation experiments. Then the creation was originated follow the processes: doing completely sketches, and then involving to work with painting in Pop art by acrylic on canvas.

True to its purpose from the original composition, I have completed the work on this project in accordance with the content and concepts in each works. 2. Form and technique

My works in the form of painting by acrylic color on canvas.

Scope of creation

1. Scope of content

I focused on exploiting the object is the dog wander on Thai soil and study the image about culture, architecture, of Thailand. Then I combine both these objects to my art works.

2. Scope of style

My style in this works is the nature and authenticity of the characters I use to transmit. I want my works closer to people so I chose Pop style to present (In my works, I present the simple image - fun colors).



3. Scope of technique

I using Photoshop software to support the photo data turn to simple images, adding color to the object I wish to mention at the end of the recording material in the form of photography. So, the sketching step is done mainly on computer. Then the works will be done in the form of painting by acrylic color on canvas.

Operation of the creation

When I already had idea from emotion, I began to go to find inspiration and gathering documents data by entering actual work with multiple locations to learn life of dogs roam and explore Thai culture also.

Photography is my main form to collect data for creative works. After had the documentary data I start to focus and to selection for make sketches (composition, color, ...) based on the software Photoshop.

Last step is make works from sketch.

1. Data collection

1.1 Source of Inspiration

My inspiration comes from dogs wandering living in the streets with many place of Thailand that I met.

1.2 Documentary data

I collect and find the document data by penetration actual and recorded them with observed and photographed.

1.3 Influence from creative work

I want my works will bring to viewers a message of optimism, love of life and happiness.

1.4 Fine arts experiments

I was work and present with two-dimensional paintings, I want by main own objects and color in my painting will tell about the message and emotional that I want to send to every people by itself.



2. Data analysis

2.1 Analysis for clarity of creation and theme

After collecting many documents related to my topic and have experienced the implementation phase to explore ways of expression, I chose two images to clearly state his ideas are: the landscape of Thailand and portraits of dogs that I had go to find and collect by my self. Two objects helps me talk clear the theme that I want to mention is: the dog wandering the streets in Thailand.

2.2 Analysis for form and symbols

I use a form of reality to bring the simple look, close and understandable to viewers. The form in my painting is the clear colors, strong lines and vivid. Wallpaper of the paintings is landscape of Thailand with many shades of color brings a hip and fun. Character focus of painting is wandering dogs with expressions of joy and happiness.

2.3 Analysis for techniques

I had try the colors of spray paint, and sometimes is array of colored pieces, lines are improvisation drawn to a spontaneous visual effectiveness. In the end, I chose to draw with Pop style, with fresh colors, bright colors of acrylic color. It is very effective for me to portrayed the contents need to mention in my works.

3. Creation of works

3.1 Making sketches

Unlike before, I usually sketch on paper by drawing. Now, after I have data by image, I use the photoshop software to create the desired outline. It suits my drawing style and using that tool has saved my time to focus on the implementation of works.

3.2 Creation of works

After I have the sketch, I stretch the canvas on wood frame with overall size is 150 x 210 cm. After that period I made zooming done in pencil and drawing by acrylic color.

Definition of Terms

Since 1960, Pop art from America spread to Europe and tranform into new figurative (Nouvelle Figuration), new reality (Nouveau Realisme). With that image I was really filled by emotion and had to be inspired to seek out and creative the works about street dogs here.






Figure 1 Go to collect image data




Figure 23 Some works of Banksy in the wall between Palestin and Israel




Figure 24 Graffiti on wall of El – Mac

Here are some first works, before I go to the final theme is about wandering dogs.

Conceptual Framework

From the mind of a person have special feelings about dogs, plus the emotional of witness when saw a real freedom life of wandering dogs living in Thailand. From these two factors have created in me an overwhelming inspiration of happiness, joy and optimism in life. And I tried to turn it into inspirational messages of happiness in the language of painting.

Through works of art in this project, I wish to share with everyone about the fun, happiness through the lovely pictures, happy life of wandering dogs are enjoying the freedom and human interest give them in a society with many colors.

And through this work, I also wish to express their feelings about living away from home. A warm feelings, happy when I living with Thai people, they gave me the feeling like being at home. That's one reason I do art projects: "Everywhere is home".

1. Idea, Concept

I get ideas from dogs living on the streets. Through the dog in my works, I want to talking about the happiness and joy of mine.

2. Form

In my works have two objects:

Image focus is dogs with black and white colors. I refer to the simplicity of the dogs that wander with their lives.

Another object is the iconic landscape of Thailand (the place in which the wandering dogs is living). Different with the central figure in my works, I use bright colors, fresh with lots of different colors to show colorful of life in outside, the pleasure that dogs are welcome. And I want to change the vision of the dogs, instead of that dogs



or cats just can see the sharp black and white (like the TV does not have the color we see in the 80's and earlier), now I want to keep them overlooking the outside world with more many colors.

3. Media, Techniques

I use a digital camera Pentax K7 - to collect material, then used Photoshop software to make sketches.

Paintings is visual works I want talk about this theme. Material I used to draw is Acrylic color on canvas.

4. Arts Style

Art form in my works that I created under the category of Pop art and the colors blend a little bit of Graffiti art.

METHODOLOGY

Sketches

First, I make sketches form of drawing on paper with pencil, pen, water color, oil color pen .. But later, I change to make sketch by Photoshop software because the data that I collected is image is taken when during the actual observations.




Figure 26 Stuff for make sketch on paper




Figure 32 Choose dogs



Material and Equipment

I prepare the wood frame with the size had set and make frame with the support of: band saws, hammers, nails, wood bar. After I finished the frame, I used nail gun to attach white canvas (which has a primer on the surface) fixed to the frame.

Materials I use to draw is acrylic color.

Tools for drawing include: Brushes (various sizes), palette, ruler, cardboard, paper tape, knives, brush..

Work creation

Initially I painted many different forms around the topic about dogs. But through many search and suggestions from the reasonable-minded on the subject from the visual teacher in visual arts class, especially is artist Assoc. Prof. Boontan Chettasurat in charge of painting class and professors from fine arts university Silpakon, from the comments that have helped me realize the problem faster. From the experiences in the learning process, I have distilled the image as well as more detail, more clear on the subject for my art project.

- Works in step 1
 Make sketches on Photoshop software.
- 2. Works in step 2Enlarge picture frame on canvas with a pencil.
- 3. Works in step 3Start put the color from light to dark in hues gradually.
- 4. Works in step 4

Settlement space of the works. I like this step, because sometimes I do not depend on the sketching anymore, in this time I can put color by improvisation with emotional spontaneity.

5. Works in step 5

Part complete the main object of works (in my works is dogs) by black and white colors. Draw from bright colors to dark in hues gradually. Then I looked at an overview of the works and has embellished the image, lines, colors by my view before signing.




Figure 42 Works in step 2

I began to explore this subject from the very first day in Thailand. I explore and experiment with different forms and techniques and different materials to highlight the concept of my works.

But through the first marking period of my thesis works, I also noted a few comments from the faculty to make more clear works for my content. From the evaluation process, I will endeavor to explore more creative ways to make the later works is better.

Here are a few suggestions from the my teachers that I think is reasonable and can be developed at the request of the teacher as well as my thinking ways to develop better for my next works:

Advisors, Asst. Prof. Satit Tesana: "Try to make the dog more comfortable to good than on the content you want refers to".

Mr. Yuttana Paigapat: "Should make the main character and surrounding context closer than .."

Mr. Pisit Huttagonvijit: "The position needs to be searched and more changes to avoid boring repetition in the works.. Should find more movement of dogs, find more old dogs or ugly dogs!?"




Figure 52 Thesis works phase 1




Figure 53 Thesis works phase 2
