



ABSTRACT

This visual arts creation thesis, *Wastescape* consisted of two purposes, which were 1) to study about environmental waste and 2) to create the visual arts which was painting that expressed via form mixed waste was used from acrylic color and paint on canvas which conveyed the feeling overwhelmed by the problem of pollution, surprised at the terrible garbage situation. The operation of this creation was collected field data in Danang city where i live, documentary data Plastic waste – The current issue of polluted plastic waste, Da Nang faces the challenge of "white" pollution from plastic waste, and influence from creative work of Eduarado Srur, creative work of Chester Arnold. The data analysis was clearly analyzed in order to theme, form, technique, and process to satisfy of concept and specially character for visual art work piece.

The result of this creation was found in the series of works showing the author's surprised look at the reality of environmental waste. And this creation also brought about the new particularly appearance.

CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

Inspiration

Along with the rapid development of life, the amount of waste discharged to the environment is increasing hourly. Waste appears everywhere. That is, where there are humans, there is waste.

All human activities can result in the waste and 50% of it is plastic waste, which takes hundreds to thousands of years to decompose naturally. In Vietnam, each family uses one kilogram of plastic bags every month. In big cities, every day about 80 tons of plastic waste is discharged into the environment, but only 10% of that huge amount is treated, the rest is buried or discharged directly into the environment.

Today's fast-paced life makes many people have the habit of using disposable plastic items because they are quick, convenient, and do not need to be cleaned. Plastics are cheap, eye-catching, and easily accessible, especially for young people. After having fun, they threw away a lot of plastic bottles, plastic bags, and fast food boxes on the crowded streets, making the collection and handling work difficult.

The above alarming situation leads to serious environmental damage. The consequence is terrible. Animals in nature can die when eating plastic waste, leading to ecological imbalance. Plastic waste releases dioxins, causing air pollution and cancer poisoning for humans when burnt. When plastics are buried in the ground, the soil cannot hold water, preventing oxygen and imposing adverse impacts to plants and microorganisms in the soil. When waste is thrown into the sea, they pollute water sources, destroy the water environment, and endanger harmful to marine life. Nowadays, it is easy to see plastic waste, water bottles, cans, plastic waste, plastic litter on the street or even giant waste dumps with countless different shapes and colors.

The work is inspired by the fact that plastic waste is rampant to replace and encroach on the beauty of the natural environment. The picture of piled-up waste

areas, the diversified colors, and the shapes of waste interwoven like a separate world created a new paradise of waste and pollution in today's modern life.

From this source of inspiration and emotion, visual artwork is created to convey the overwhelming emotion, stinging before pollution, and at the same time a satirical look at the crisis and the bad side evils of modern society.

Purpose of Creation

- 1. To study images of plastic bottles, plastic waste such as canned goods, fast food packaging with many colors and shapes to create works.
- 2. To create the visual arts which was painting on canvas that expressed via form huge pile of waste was used from acrylic colors and surface techniques combined with painting by brush which conveyed the painful emotions, the author's sarcastic look at the problems of life.

Scope of Creation

1. Content.

Overwhelming emotions and diverse colors created an indeterminate space like a beautiful paradise hidden by the opposite reality, an issue of society.

2. Form

Plastic waste is discharged into the environment with many different shapes: sometimes it is distorted and sometimes it is crushed, stacked, or rolled. Dark colors are for the background space, while vibrant colors are outstanding from overlapping bottles and boxes.

3. Techniques

Using acrylic paint on canvas with vibrant colors contrasting strongly against the dark virtual space to represent an ambiguous concept. Liquid acrylic is used to create a dithering effect, overlapping layers of color with a trowel for various forms and dimensions for visual effects. Using a brush on a dry-colored background to evoke the look of plastic waste.

Conceptual of Frame Work

Along with the development of society, waste and environmental pollution are becoming a serious issue, especially plastic waste pollution, they are diverse, colorful and the quantity is getting more and more, everywhere I see plastic waste, I feel that they become beautiful, attractive and reflect the face of today's social life. That's why I want to call them heaven and also use it to name my thesis. Pictures of waste areas, disposable plastics are easily found on the street or in the city's huge waste collection areas. Using images of plastic bottles that are distorted, piled up, flipped in directions and interwoven colors on the background of a vague space with dark colors creates a strong contrast. At first glance, it feels like a new world, a beautiful and colorful paradise. The work is the author's painful feelings about a polluted environment, a separate paradise of overflowing waste which loses the beauty of nature and also is a warning about the current situation, the dark side of modernity in today's society.






Figure 1 Conceptual of Frame Work

Documentary Data

Every day we use a lot of products made from plastic because of its convenience. However, the lack of awareness has caused many consequences for the environment. A plastic bottle takes 100 to 1000 years to decompose. In fact, they are broken down into microscopic fibers and easily mixed into the food of people and animals. Nonetheless, the investment in plastic waste treatment machinery cannot catch up with the real situation.

An Phat Holdings (2020: Online)According to a report by the United Nations, every year the world generates about 300 million tons of plastic waste. But the treatment technique is ineffective and rusty, causing a rapid increase in the volume of plastic waste in the environment. Plastic waste is plastic products that have been used and discharged into the environment such as: plastic bags, plastic bottles, plastic straws, synthetic plastics, and so on. Plastic waste is discharged into the environment from various sources such as: domestic waste, industrial activities, waste from tourist areas, services, medical waste, imported goods and so on.

VOV (2018: Online) For many years, Da Nang City has set out many measures to collect plastic waste. However, plastic waste problems in seaside residential areas still occur. At fishing ports, boat locks, plastic bags, plastic bottles, and styrofoam containers of used seafood are dumped indiscriminately by many people who lack awareness. After each heavy rain, the seaside is filled with waste, plastic bags stuck in the sewers, causing white pollution. People seem to have to live with waste.

Theory

Lev Tolstoy defines art as a form of conveying emotions to others and reflecting human and social problems. According to Tolstoy, in order to properly understand art, we need to break the habit of seeing art as a tool for pleasure and an activity for creating beauty. Since beauty is a subjective concept, no objective criteria can be set to define what is art and where is art.

Beauty in art is expressive. A beautiful scene in nature does not contain in itself sentimental and emotion. It has only physical attributes, or is attributed to it by human subjective associations. As for beauty in art, it is a crystallization which contains the emotions of the authors and perceived by the viewers. "Beauty is in the eye of the beholder" (Kant, 1970).

Influence from Visual Arts

1. Visual Arts from Other Artists

1.1 Visual Arts from Eduarado Srur did not use paints to make the works. He used entirely plastic pieces of waste collected on the banks of polluted rivers then recreated the works of famous artists. The work The Scream reproduces from the original by the artist Edvard Munch, attracting viewers and as a panic before the problem of plastic pollution. "These works will last many centuries in human history, and so will the plastic that we are discharging in nature" (Eduarado Srur, 2021: Online).

2.1 Pre – Thesis work 1

Concept: Difficulties of Labors

Form: Images of hand laborers, having difficult and

impoverished conditions, unable to keep up with the rapid development of industry and having to do hard works.

Art style: Realism

Technique and the Result: Using acrylic background techniques to enrich the color and roughness of the surface, using oil paint to create shapes and details to complete the artwork.

Deep tones, rough surface combined with messy shabby scenes depicting the hardships and impoverished conditions.

Concept: The reverse of the medal

Form: Using the image of used plastic bottles in a large number

of overlaps.

Art style: Expressionism

Technique and the Result: Using acrylic surfacing techniques, using a trowel to create many cuts and rough edges of the surface, using oil paints to create shapes and details to complete the work.

Deep tones, rough surfaces combined with images of piled up plastic waste create rhythm and increase the seriousness of the concept.

shape

Art style: Abstract expressionism

Technique and the Result: Use free-falling diluted acrylic colors to create colorful dithers, use a trowel to create many cuts and rough edges of the surface, use oil paints to shape and drop details to complete the artwork.

Colorful and free-form plastic waste stands out against a dark background creating the effect of colorful flowers rising above the dark filth. It shows an ironic look that the beauty of nature is no longer there, but beauty from waste and the crisis of today's modern industrial life.

- 3.1 Thesis Proposal work 1
 - Idea/ Concept: The Beauty of Life Crisis.
- Form: The image of waste is hidden with many colorful shapes overlapping to form an image like brilliant flowers, standing out on a dark background.
- -Technique: Create surface with acrylic color by painting trowel, spread liquid acrylic color to create colorful effects, dry the base layer with a dryer, use brush to shape and complete the artwork.
- Result: Colorful waste images, prominent shapes on the background. The lines of color evoke images of colorful flowers but are actually just trash. It's an implicit comparison. It can express the author's ironic view of the pollution problem and the dark sides of modern life.




Figure 19 Title: The flower of life crisis 5

- Form: The image of plastic waste is hidden with many colorful shapes overlapping to form an indeterminate shape, striking against the dark background.

-Technique: Create surface with acrylic color by painting trowel, spread liquid acrylic color to create colorful effects, dry the base layer with a dryer, use brush to shape and complete the artwork.

- Result: The image of waste is varied in many colors, striking shapes on the background. Interwoven multi-dimensional lines suggest an illusory world like a beautiful paradise, but it is actually waste. This is a consequence of industrial life. It can express the author's ironic look at the problem of pollution and the dark side of modern life.

CHAPTER III CREATIVITY METHODS

This chapter gives an outline of the study design and procedure. The procedure of the study concluded from chapter two and other frameworks which involve with *Wastescape*. This creation will be presented according to the following topics:

- 1. Collection and Analysis Data
- 2. Visual Arts Experimentation
- 3. Creation Process
- 4. Dissemination Process

Collection and Analysis Data

1. Data Collection

Waste appeared everywhere, so I chose to collect data by taking pictures in reality. Go to waste areas or waste dumps at the edge of residential areas, along rivers, along the coast to take pictures.

2. Data Analysis

2.1 Analysis of theme

Through this thesis, I use the image of waste to reflect the state of environmental pollution. At the same time, I would like to express my opinion and ironic look at the reality and consequences of modern life.

2.2 Analysis of form symbols

The artwork takes advantage of plastic waste pictures with many colors, represented by overlapping lines, interwoven in many dimensions. Many colors of them expressed the complexity and crisis behind the beauty outside of society.

The background of the artwork uses dark colors with faint line details representing the dark areas, problems, and existing painful realities.

2.3 Analysis of techniques

The artwork uses the acrylic paint technique on canvas. Brilliant acrylic colors are applied on the surface by flaking paint combined with painting trowel, adding water in the process for easy dilution and blend together, creating free-flowing cut lines to get the overall harmony, random color layout, and raised background.

After the base layer has dried, use a large brush to create a general shape and overall composition. In the process of using the pen, I combined it with water mist spray to match the colors and easily move the pen. The small brush is used for the final step to emphasize the image of plastic waste, which adjusts each area to clarify or blur the subject and complete the work.

Visual Arts Experimentation

The creative process uses liquid acrylic colors with vibrant tones to create the overall color scheme.

- Step 1: Apply fresh acrylic color on canvas.
- Step 2: Combine painting and drawing to get more color and various cuts, streaks, and lines to create roughness on the canvas surface.
- Step 3: Spray water on some predefined locations to create a gradation effect, especially the outer edge of the artwork.
 - Step 4: Use a large brush to shape the work with acrylic colors.
- Step 5: Use a brush to add color, adjust the color to emphasize the shape of the plastic waste to complete the work.

Creation Process

.1Sketches/ Model

From the collected material images to artwork, it is necessary to have sketches and ideas process. This process is to select the subjects and the methods to introduce it into the artwork.

Acrylic colors are used to create the basic color scheme and layout, from which to choose the appropriate shape and style.






Figure 37 Sketch 8




Figure 38 Canvas frame

Results of Data Analysis

After collecting data through practice and through books and the internet, I realized that waste and environmental pollution are too terrible, which is a burning problem of the whole society. Waste has many types, shapes and designs, piled up in big, messy piles. The more modern life is, the more people's life develops, the more waste and pollution become heavier. I was surprised and hurt by the data i found.



Results of Creation

1. Thesis work 1

- 1.1 Idea/Concept: floating garbage that does not decompose and blends together to create interesting artistic shapes.
- 1.2 Form and Art style: plastic waste, dense floating bottles that cannot be decomposed in the sea are piled up and intertwined with each other.
- 1.3 The Results: waste is piled up, creating interesting visual effects of many colors, many layers and layers, giving the feeling of dense waste.

3. The new finding/ the new knowledge


I feel that my creative work uses visual elements such as lines, color patches, and tones mainly to express emotions, not to use too obvious garbage images. Random color elements and effects are used.
